Further survived by other relatives and friends. Dr. Scherman, a retired Milwaukee Internist with a specialty in Nephrology, died Wednesday February 25th at Froedtert Hospital. Graduated from Marquette University in 1955 with his Medical Degree, he became Captain in the Air Force and served in Spain, where he married in 1959. He completed his Medical Residency at the V.A., and moved then to work for the old St. Mary's Hospital. Doctor of Medicine, Assistant Clinical Professor in the Department of Medicine of the Medical College of Wisconsin, received Performance and Appreciation Awards, for his work as physician and as an excellent human being. From them, only to mention two examples: the Award of Department of Veteran Affairs in "appreciation of 35 years of faithful service to the United States Government", and the Certificate of "Recognition and Appreciation", with "special thanks from the patients and Staff of for Accomplishments, Dedication and the Compassion shown toward the Veterans". He obtained the "Certificate of Retirement" June 30th 1995, following dedicated service

for 38 years.
