A crew leader early in his career for the State of Wisconsin neighborhood revival project in the city, Jim advocated for his crew to receive living wages. He volunteered at every school event for his children and loved most to spend time with his family. Nicknamed ""Fish"" in childhood, his love of the outdoors and fishing is reflected in his art and in the wonderful memories he created with his family and friends.
